"Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired, but a body have you prepared for me;


- ⁶in burnt offerings and sin offerings you have taken no pleasure.
- ⁷Then I said, 'Behold, I have come to do your will, O God, as it is written of me in the scroll of the book.'"




